The Lookout Transfer Station, located at 1601 Lookout Drive, is one of three transfer stations owned, maintained, and operated by the NTMWD. Transfer stations serve as a waypoint for solid waste, where solid waste is transferred from smaller capacity city vehicles to larger capacity NTMWD vehicles and then taken to the landfill (near Melissa). This transfer process saves money by ensuring that city vehicles do not have to travel the distance to the landfill. Age and use have made a total reconstruction of the Lookout Transfer Station necessary.

It is the goal of City of Richardson and the NTMWD to address the comments and concerns of interested citizens during this informational meeting. A question and answer session will follow the presentation. We thank you for your interest in this project as improvements are sought to the overall solid waste service in Richardson.
