



Peak Performance Awards

The North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD) has been selected to receive Gold, Silver and Platinum Peak Performance Awards. The Peak Performance Awards program presented by the National Association of Clean Water Agencies (NACWA) recognizes public wastewater treatment facilities for their outstanding compliance records in the 2010 calendar year. NACWA was proud to recognize these and other awards during the Association's 2011 Summer Conference held in Chicago, Illinois.

NTMWD received 14 Peak Performance Awards as follows:

Platinum Awards pay special tribute to agency facilities that have received Gold Awards for five consecutive years or more.

Gold Awards honor treatment works that have achieved 100 percent compliance with their NPDES permit for an entire calendar year.
