## Repairs Underway for Ammonia Tank Leak at Wylie Water Treatment Plant

No injuries, no evacuations, no impacts to water quality

WYLIE, TX – July 24, 2017 -- The Wylie Fire Department and crews from the North Texas Municipal Water District responded to a leaking ammonia storage tank at the NTMWD Wylie water treatment plant. NTMWD crews, at approximately 8:00 Monday morning, noticed a small leak on the connection that was repaired early Sunday morning.

The leak was stopped on Monday morning and crews are removing the remaining ammonia from the tank.

Water treatment operations are continuing with no impacts to water quality or delivery.

Ongoing air monitoring will occur as long as needed.
