WATER LOSS AUDIT TRAINING IN WYLIE

The Texas Water Development Board has scheduled a [Water Loss](#)

[Audit Workshop in Wylie](#) February 26 at the North Texas Municipal Water District. This training satisfies recent legislation requiring that water loss audits submitted to TWDB be completed by an individual trained in water loss auditing.



The rule became effective on January 1, 2019 for the 2018 water loss audits. Attendance at a TWDB Water Loss Audit Workshop satisfies this requirement and four hours of continuing education credits are available for licensed water operators.
