

## **WYLIE WTP AIR PERMIT**

During an environmental audit, NTMWD found the eight ammonia tanks at the Wylie Water Treatment Plants lacked a necessary permit. The District is applying for this permit.

No ammonia tanks are being added, and current plant operations will not change.

This permit simply allows continued operation of the existing tanks.


Additionally, NTMWD is in the process of converting to liquid ammonia, which will eliminate the need to store gas.


The District expects to complete this conversion in late 2022.

- District continues to have safety measures in place to reduce hazards
- Daily inspections and equipment checks
- Equipment maintenance performed by trained mechanics
- Systems inspected annually by a third party expert
- District performs internal audits and subject to EPA audits
- District actively engages with Wylie Fire Dept as part of our Emergency Action Plan
- NTMWD staff train/cross train with Wylie FD on response to potential chemical leaks
