

SOLID WASTE COMMITTEE

HISTORY

- Presented at November 17, 2021 Real Estate Committee meeting.
- This item is on the December Consent Agenda, Item 2021-12-10.
- City of Melissa requests easements for the extension of its Stiff Creek Gravity Sewer Line to the north of State Hwy 121 to allow for additional residential development in the area.
- One Permanent Easement and two Temporary Construction Easements encumbers a parcel of land north of State Hwy 121.
- One Permanent Easement and one Temporary Construction Easement encumbers the 121 RDF permit boundary, parallel to State Hwy 121.
- A section of permanent fencing along the 121 RDF permit boundary will be removed and temporary fencing erected through construction. The section of permanent fencing will be reinstalled or replaced after construction.
- There is negligible cost associated with granting this easement.
- There is no anticipated impact to the operations of 121 RDF.

Potential Schedule

- April 2022 Award preliminary engineering services
- June 2022 Purchase property
- July 2022 Begin Frisco & TCEQ permitting
- April 2024 Final design award
- March 2025 Construction award
- September 2026 Operational
- Add at least one year if contested case hearing
- *Will return to Solid Waste Committee before property purchase

UPDATE ON PARKWAY TRANSFER STATION PERMIT AMENDMENT

- Convert from compactors to single tunnel top load
- Increase permitted waste acceptance from 770 tons per day (tpd) to 1,500 tpd, averaged over 365 days per year
- Plano approved Civil and Landscape Plans
 - Waiting for revised site plan and replat approval
- February 2022 Submit application to TCEQ
- May 2022 Final design award
- March 2023 Construction award
- May 2024 Operational
- Add at least one year if contested case hearing
- *Will return to Solid Waste Committee before final design award
