


CRANDALL WATER CONTRACT AMENDMENT

BACKGROUND

- NTMWD and City of Crandall previously entered into the Potable Water Supply Contract September 8, 2020
- The Contract required City of Crandall to construct its new Point of Delivery within two (2) years from the Contract Date
- City of Crandall completing design and anticipate awarding construction in 2023
- City requested an extension of an additional twenty-four (24) months to complete the construction
- Amended contract allots four (4) years from the original Contract Date
- Special Conditions to require City of Crandall enter into a new Potable Water Supply Contract after construction is complete
- Crandall City Council approved this contract amendment at its June 6, 2022 meeting.









RECOMMENDATION

















CITY OF JOSEPHINE AMENDED WATER DELIVERY POINT







BACKGROUND & SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

PROJECT PURPOSE

- City of Josephine entered into a potable water supply contract with NTMWD on March 31, 1995, with a contract term of 30 years.
- City of Josephine has requested a new agreement to address the following:
 - Update agreement to include language that addresses use of the new Member City methodology, "that minimum amount shall be the value as calculated by using the same methodology as applied to the Member Cities."
 - The potable water supply contract conforms to the new customer contract language.





SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

COMPONENTS OF THE CONTRACT WITH CITY OF JOSEPHINE

- Contract term of 20 years
- Contract will provide new methodology for calculating annual minimums
- An annual maximum of 365,000,000 gallons per year
- Cost of potable water is set at the current water rate established for customer entities by the Board of Directors
- Any water delivered in excess of the annual minimum will also be purchased at the water rate established by the Board of Directors
- Josephine City Council approved the contract at their June 13, 2022, meeting.



RECOMMENDATION

The Executive Director, NTMWD staff and Lloyd, Gosselink, Rochelle & Townsend, P. C., recommend the Board of Directors authorize execution of a potable water supply contract with the City of Josephine.
