- Keep your toilet free of hygiene products and wipes, as well as any and all other trash.


DON'T POUR FATS.



Pour grease and fats into empty soup or coffee cans. Once it solidifies, throw it away in the

- trash. Take used cooking oil to a cooking oil recycling center. Put leftover food scraps into the trash or compost bin. Scrape your plates and pans clean and soak up
